

Weapons Incident Checklist

Be Prepared

- Create a codeReady Plan that includes a Stay Plan and a Go Plan (which one you use will depend on the type of weapon).
- Build a 3-day codeReady Kit. (You may need to take part or all of this kit with you if you leave your home.)

Prevent Incidents

- Lock up guns, unloaded, so they're not easily accessible to children.
- Lock and store ammunition separately from guns.
- Talk to your children about weapons and safety issues.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Report any suspicious activity to authorities.
